During this symposium, internationally renowned speakers will share their experience in Transanal TME, the new treatment option, which is expected to revolutionize the surgical treatment of rectal cancer. There are several reasons for this slow implementation of TaTME, such as the lack of the new instruments and equipment required, due to hard economic times, but, even more important, the fact that TaTME is a technically demanding procedure with a long learning curve. In addition, reports on serious potential complications might make surgeons doubtful to embark in TaTME. Therefore, proper training and -especially- proctoring is mandatory for the successful implementation of this new technique, as it happens with every new technique. All the aforementioned issues will be discussed in detail with our international guests, coming from some of the most important European TaTME leading centers.

We look forward to welcoming you to Larissa for a productive and educational meeting.
